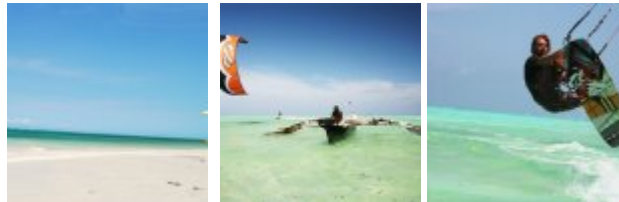

Kitesurf in Zanzibar



Learn and enjoy the exhilarating sport of kitesurfing in the warm, blue waters off Zanzibar. Covering the whole of the east coast, Kitecentre Zanzibar, the first kitesurfing school in Tanzania has three centres in Paje, Matemwe and Kiwengwa, Nungwi. The instructors have over nine years' experience and teach all levels from beginner to professional.

Enjoying all year round temperatures of between 28 and 30 degrees and water temperatures around 26 degrees, the island also has amazing 'down-winders' of up to 30 kilometres non-stop. The best time to kitesurf off Zanzibar is between June and September, and between December and February.

Kitesurfing can be combined with the many other watersports available on Zanzibar, including kayaking, snorkelling, scuba diving and dhow sailing.

Stay at Bellevue Guest House on Zanzibar for 7 nights on a B&B basis from £200 per person in high season (excluding flights and transfers). Introduction to Kitesurfing instruction: £82 for 3 hours (4 pax in class); private lesson: £36/hour. Kitesurf hire: £36 for 2 hours; £72 for a day.
